To help our students' foster friendships and to learn their music in a fun and enjoyable environment, Adelaide Youth Sinfonia will be having a camp from Friday 16 March 2012 5.30pm, **with dinner at 6.30pm** to Sunday 18 March 2012 2pm at Mylor Baptist Campsite.

During the weekend, students will also participate, subject to weather, in a low-risk adventure activity. If you don't wish your child to partake in this, you must let us know.

Adelaide Youth Orchestras has selected this campsite, as it is a safe and well managed site, with appropriate rehearsal spaces, while being relatively close to Adelaide.

The cost for each student to attend the camp is \$160.00 which covers all of the camp's costs. All participants will need to provide their own transport to and from the campsite.

So that the students can gain the most from the camp, students must attend the whole camp, except in exceptional circumstances.

To ensure your child's safety whilst attending the camp, we require everyone to complete the camp form online by no later than **Monday 13 February 2012**.

As part of our commitment to child safety, we need six parent volunteers to attend the camp, to provide assistance with supervision, serving meals and the smooth running of the camp. Any parent helping at the camp will need to have a current National Police Certificate or Teacher's Registration Certificate. AdYO can assist you with obtaining a National Police Certificate at no cost to you.

To help make the camp an enjoyable experience, please find below some directions and a packing list.

Directions to get here

1. Take the South Eastern Freeway from Adelaide and turn off at the Stirling Exit.
2. Follow the main road (Strathalbyn Road) through Stirling, through Aldgate and on to Mylor.
3. 500 metres out of Mylor (towards Echunga) turn RIGHT on to Silver Lake Road.
4. Approximately 2 km along Silver Lake Road turn LEFT onto Wingrove Road, past the large MYLOR BAPTIST CAMP sign on the corner, and continue for 200 metres to the main car park on the LEFT side of the road.
